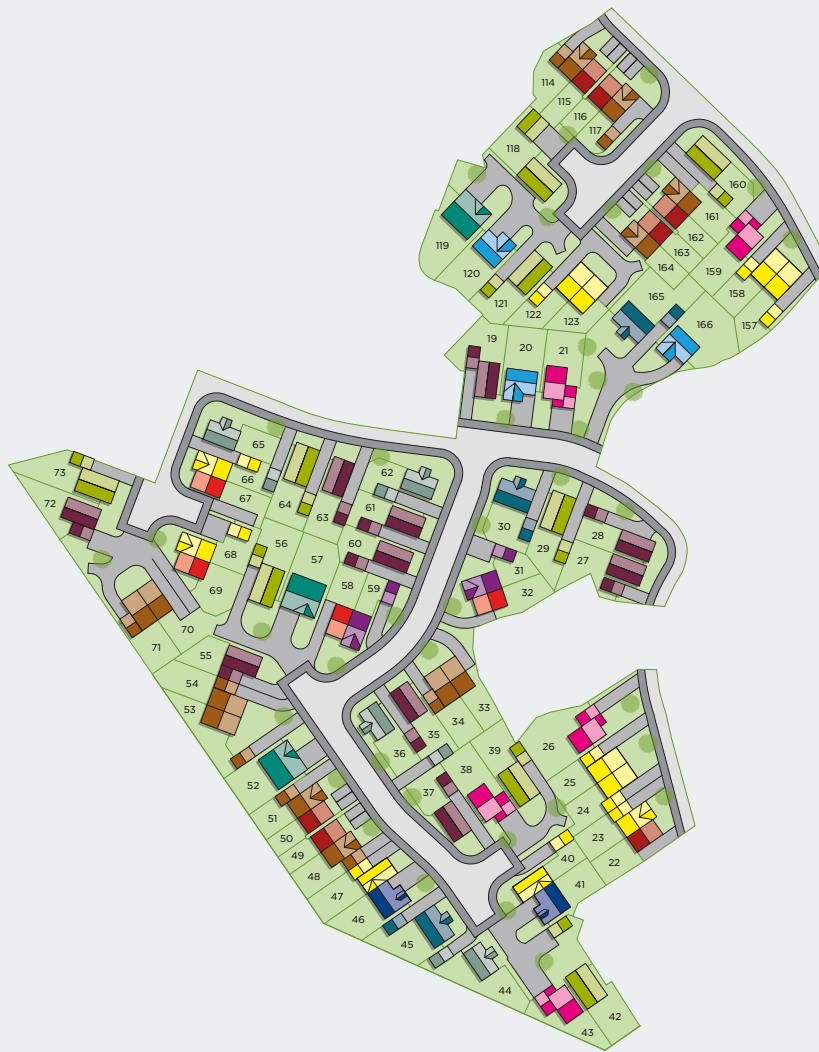


Welcome to
